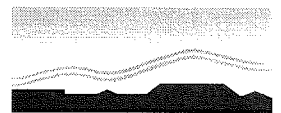

Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am writing to invite your child to participate the whole school Wrekin Walk for the Georgia Williams Trust.

On Tuesday the 17th of July we plan to escort groups of pupils on a 5-mile walk from school to the top of the Wrekin and back. A member of staff will accompany small groups of pupils with marshals stationed along the route, courtesy of our business partners Fujitsu.

There is no obligation to participate in the walk and should you feel that it would not be suitable for your child please indicate on the slip below. Activities are planned for those that remain on site. However it is our hope that as many pupils as possible can enjoy what is a stunning view, right on our doorstep. If there are insufficient numbers, then the walk will not go ahead.

As you know we are keen supporters of the Georgia Williams Trust and its motto is very apt for this event, 'Free your spirit – join in!' They have been very supportive of the school, giving us access to resources such as the trampolines, providing experiences that might not have been available to our pupils.

We would like to give something back to the Trust, in support of their excellent work, by suggesting that participants raise a pledge of between £1 and £5, which will be collected on the day. Please note this is not obligatory.

The walk is anticipated to take approximately 2.5 hours, each year group having a staggered departure time. The last group back should be around 3.15pm, in time for a normal finish. Suitable clothing and footwear must be worn, as such, all participating pupils should be in Ercall Wood PE kit. Pupils should also be prepared for weather conditions, hat and sun cream if particularly sunny and a light rain coat in the event of a shower. Fujitsu are providing water but we would also suggest that pupils bring a packed lunch should they become hungry on the walk. Pupils eligible for Free School Meals can collect a packed lunch from the canteen in the morning.

For those taking part we must have the attached medical form printed, completed and handed in by Friday 6th July. Forms not submitted by this time will not be accepted and your child cannot participate. Hard copies are available at reception on request.

If you have any questions about the day please do not hesitate to contact the school and we look forward to what promises to be an enjoyable event to mark the end of another successful year at Ercall Wood.

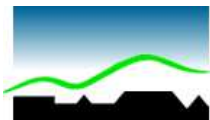
