Academy Uniform

We would like to thank Parents for their continued support with regard to our high expectations of uniform. Most students come to school smartly dressed and remain so throughout the academy day, but sadly we have over the Summer term noticed an influx of girls wearing exceptionally short lycra skirts, or very tight 'jeggin' style trousers. We would like to remind parents of our expectations with Academy Uniform. The uniform is listed in the student planner and Academy prospectus as shown below. **Failure to comply with these rules will result in sanctions being issued** to those students who wear items not deemed appropriate at the start of the new term in September:-

My Academy Uniform

Blue Shirt – long or short sleeved
Ercall Wood tie or blue tie for year 11 Prefects
Black formal style skirt (no shorter than 10cm above the knee)
or
Black Formal trousers for girls – *see Appendix for images overleaf*
Black formal trousers for boys– *see Appendix for images overleaf*
Black V-necked jumper or Blue V-neck jumper for Year 11 students with Ercall Wood logo
Black sensible shoes – leather or leather type - *see Appendix for images overleaf*
College blazer with Ercall Wood logo
Outdoor Coat

The following items are not part of academy uniform and must not be worn

'Fashion' shirt/trousers/shoes/leggings/jean style/ skin tight trousers
Short lycra skirts more than 10cm above the knee
Trainers or canvas pumps
Boots – knee length or ankle
Non-school sweatshirts and cardigans even if black
Hoodies/baseball caps/tracksuit tops/casual jackets
Body piercing – other than 1 plain stud in each ear lobe
Jewellery - except a watch

At this time of year as parents we are replacing uniform, and FEW (Friends of Ercall Wood) have offered a uniform recycling scheme. Therefore any clean outgrown or unwanted items including PE Kit will be warmly welcomed and can be brought in on Wednesday 18th July, Pastoral Review Day and dropped off at a designated area.
